## Gift Aid Declaration Form

Gift Aid is a way that for every pound you give, we get an extra 28 pence from the Inland Revenue, helping your donation go further. This means that £10 can be turned into £12.80 just so long as donations are made through Gift Aid. Imagine what a difference that could make, and it doesn't cost you a thing. So if you want your donation to go further, Gift Aid it.

Pancreatic Cancer Action will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008. Pancreatic Cancer Action will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008. The Government will pay to Pancreatic Cancer Action an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011.
